Thank you for your interest in LNC! We have three general areas of internships, and students can choose to focus on one or a combination.

- **1. Environmental Education:** work with education programs (all ages--we can tailor this to working with children ages 4-12, or developing and leading adult programs.)
- 2. Forest Restoration (invasive species removal, native species planting)
- **3. General Non-profit internship** (groundskeeping, guest services, office assistance, social media, other duties depending on skill level and interest.)

There are other areas that we can consider for internships, but would require a student that is able to work very independently and is very self-driven. These could be:

- species inventories/surveys
- developing sustainability programming/recommendations, or
- botany--take on the garden bed outside the building and turn it into a native plant landscape.
